NOTICE OF RACE

Venue: Greve Marina, Greve, Denmark

Organising Authority: Sejlklubben Køge Bugt

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*. Danish national prescriptions that apply are incorporated in the NoR.
- 1.2 All competitors shall wear a whistle attached to their personal flotation device. All boats shall carry a painter (tow line) at least 8m in length (measured from the bow) and at least 6mm in nominal diameter, permanently attached to the standard fitting point in front of the mast. *[DP]*
- 1.3 All support boats are required to carry personal flotation devices for every person on board. This comes from national Danish law and applies for all boats afloat.
- 1.4 All drivers of support boats must use an engine cut-off / kill cord at all times when the support boat engine is turned on and in gear. Failure to do so may result in the boat in question being banned from accessing the sailing area throughout the duration of the event.
- 1.5 There will be no right of appeal as described in RRS 70.5.
- 1.6 Appendix P will apply. RRS P2.2 and RRS P2.3 will not apply, and RRS P2.1 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. *[DP]*

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to RS Tera sailboats with the RS Tera Pro and RS Tera Sport rigs. .
- 3.2 All competitors shall be members of the International RS Tera Class Association (IRSTCA). The membership fee is included in the entry fee. By registering, participants agree to become members of the International RS Tera Class Association.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter online via the dedicated 'RS Tera Events' section of the www.rssailing.club website
- 3.4 The following age limits apply:
RS Tera Pro: aged 19 or under, on December 31st, 2024.
RS Tera Sport: aged 16 or under on December 31st, 2024.
- 3.5 A Parent/Guardian Consent and supervision form must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian of any competitor under 18 (on 3 August 2024) and presented upon registration at the event venue. This form is available to download via the 'General Race Info' section of the RSSailing.Club RS Tera Worlds 2024 event entry site or via the 'Documents' sub-heading of the 'Association' tab on the International RS Tera Class Website,

4 FEES

- 4.1 To qualify for the quoted entry fee, entry as well as payment must be completed by the deadline stated in item 4.1.2 of the NoR. All times are noted as Central European Time (CET).
 - 4.1.1 Early Bird: €300 per boat for entry on or before midnight on March 1st, 2024.
 - 4.1.2 Normal Entry: €450 per boat for all entries received from March 2nd, 2024.

- 4.1.3 Any entries after midnight on June 1st, 2024 are at the sole discretion of the organising authority.
- 4.2 Refunds for cancellation of entries will be as follows:
- 4.2.1 A full refund of the entry fee paid, less €10 administration fee, for cancellations up to midnight on June 1st, 2024
- 4.2.2 No refunds for cancellations after June 1st, 2024.
- 4.3 The event entry fee includes:
- a competitor's entry pack and a national flag to be applied to the mainsail.
 - A racing lunch and after racing snack for all competitors
 - a ticket for each competitor to the midweek dinner.
- Additional tickets may be purchased at registration.
- 4.4 If the organising authority cancels the event due to Corona restrictions or other similar extraordinary circumstances, the entry fee will be refunded in full. This guarantee is underwritten by the Greve Municipality.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.
- 5.2 On the first day of sailing the warning signal will be given at 11:00.
- 5.3 On Thursday August 8th, 2024 no warning signal will be made after 15:00.
- 5.4 Briefing for competitors will be held on Sunday, August 4th at 15:00.
- 5.5 Closing ceremony and award ceremony – Thursday August 8th, 2024 – as soon after all boats have come ashore after racing as is possible.

6 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

A number of entries will be randomly selected for pre-event equipment inspection. All boats can also be subject for random checks during the championship.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the dedicated event Manage2Sail platform no later than July 25th, 2024. The link to this platform will be sent, by email, to all competitors once the site is live.

8 SAFETY AND SUPPORT BOATS

- 8.1 Support boats may be required to display identification information handed out by the OA during the event.
- 8.2 All support boat drives must wear personal flotation devices and kill-cords when the engine is running.
- 8.3 When the race committee displays flag V with one sound, all support boats shall, if possible, monitor the race committee communication channel for search and rescue instructions (RRS37). The communication channel will be specified in SI.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

- (a) RS Tera Pro as a minimum dependent on number of entries:
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd boys
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd girls
- (b) RS Tera Sport as a minimum dependent on number of entries:
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd boys
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd girls
- (c) Titles will be awarded as follows:
 - RS Tera Pro World Champion: 1st Tera Pro overall
 - RS Tera Sport World Champion: 1st Tera Sport overall.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,000,000 Euro per incident or the equivalent.

13 CHARTER BOATS

- 13.1 Charter boats are available from RS Sailing. These boats are reserved for participants attending the event from outside of Europe and can be booked at the time of registering for the event via the 2024 RS Tera Worlds specific page in the 'RS Tera Events' section of the www.rssailing.club website.
- 13.2 Any participants from countries in Europe that wish to charter a boat for the event should contact the Organising Authority directly via email (teraworlds2024@skb.dk) as there will be a limited number of Danish boats available.
- 13.3 For all types of charter boats, Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) Appendix G3 governing CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS will apply. This appendix states that "*When so stated in the notice of race or sailing instructions, a boat chartered or loaned for an event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.*"
